

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HARPOON BEZEL REMOVAL

Tools Needed:

- Tape
- Thin blade (I use an Exacto knife)

Start by taping the case to prevent accidental scratches



Slide the blade between the case and bezel. The bezel should "pop" off. Twisting or pushing up on the blade may be necessary.



Note the position of the stainless steel octagonal spring and the white retension gasket on the underside of the bezel. They should be installed in the same manner on the ceramic bezel. The white gasket should be installed first, then the SS spring on top.



Make sure the bezel click spring is properly installed on the case. There is a "foot" on the spring that will fit into a hole in the case.



Place the ceramic bezel on the case and push down. You will hear it "snap" on. Check to make sure it properly rotates.



Tips if the bezel doesn't rotate or install properly:
- Make sure the octagonal spring and white gasket underneath are properly installed and not bent.
