Watch components

Movement - 24 jewel self-winding Miyota 9015 with 28,800 bpm

Case - All 316L solid stainless steel. Rose or yellow gold plating is optional. Water resistant to 30m (100ft)

Strap - Leather with stainless steel buckle/clasp. Also with optional rose or yellow gold plating

Crystal - (front) Sapphire with anti-reflective coating. (rear) Sapphire

Important information: Your watch has a self-winding movement. To maintain proper working order, the crown must be in position 1 during normal wear. Even though the watch is water resistant to 30m we do not recommend exposing the watch to water. To do so would void the warranty.

Winding the watch (position 1)

- Rotate the crown clockwise to wind the watch. After 20 to 30 seconds the watch will be fully wound.

Setting the date (position 2)

- Pull into position 2 (1 click). Rotate the crown clockwise until the date shows one day earlier than the day you want to set.

- Pull crown into position 3 (1 more click; 2 clicks total).

- Rotate the crown so the hands move clockwise until the correct date shows. Then set the watch hands to the proper time. Turn the watch hands past 12 once if you are setting the watch for PM time.

- Return the crown to position 1.

Setting the time (position 3)

- Pull into position 3 (2 clicks).
- Rotate the crown to set the watch hands to the proper time.
- Return the crown to position 1.

Caring for your watch

With proper maintenance, the automatic movement in your watch is made to provide a lifetime of accurate and reliable service. Boschett Timepieces recommends the watch be serviced every three to five years. Even though the watch is water resistant, it is not recommended that you expose the watch to water especially in a hot shower, sauna or hot tub. When wearing your watch be sure the crown is in position 1.

Twelve-month limited warranty

Your BOSCHETT watch is warranted by BOSCHETT TIMEPIECES, LLC for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of purchase under the terms and conditions of this warranty. This warranty covers defects in materials or workmanship existing at the time of purchase.
